- \* On the day, we retain the total quoted amount




## **INCLUDED**

- 1. Venue open from 8h00 17h00 strictly
- 2. No vehicles permitted on the lawn or at the venue
- 3. Area to be used as per diagram.
  - NO entrance to Residential areas
  - NO entrance to Hotel guests area
  - NO entrance to Trout farm
  - NO camping on lawns outside the venue
  - 2 access points to river
  - Parking only in demarcated areas
  - Public restrooms across the lawn
- 4. All minors to be under adult supervision
- 5. No loud music or noise
- 6. Do not interact with or feed the baboons
- 7. Do not litter, please use the bins provided
- 8. Fires:
  - This is a fire hazard area, please be cautious
  - Fires only to be made in the braais provided
  - Fires to be put out after braai
  - No fireworks

## 9. Fishing:

- No fishing the river without a valid permit from the Cape Piscatorial Society
- No fishing in the dams without a permit from reception
- 10. Food and drinks: own food and drinks allowed, no spit braais
